

## DETAILS FOR MERIWETHER COUNTY CLEAN UP DAY

- **Cleanup date – Saturday, September 24, 2022; 8:00 am – 4:00 pm**
- Bags of trash in container only. All bags must be taken to a container at one of the locations attached to this sheet. No bags can be left on the roadside.
- Mattresses and large items must be placed beside the container, not in it.
- All unmounted tires will only be accepted at the Meriwether County Public Works Department located at 689 County Farm Road, Greenville, Ga. 30222 (no exceptions) Only Meriwether County residents are allowed to dispose of tires. Public Works staff will man this site. No tires will be allowed at the container sites in each town. **Tires will be accepted the day of the event, September 24, 2022; from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Limit of 12 tires per person.**
- Volunteers will be placed at each site to assist with the delivery of the bags and items.

- If you see abandoned animals, call the Animal Shelter at 706/672-2966.
- Safety is our #1 priority. Watch for traffic in the area you are cleaning. If children are on your team, please watch them and keep them safe. Wear closed toed shoes and appropriate clothing for picking up litter. We will supply you with gloves and bags. Mask are recommended, especially for large groups.
- If you were on a team last year, plan to wear your Keep Meriwether Beautiful t-shirt. If you are a new team, we will supply t-shirts for all team members. You must tell us the sizes that you need.
- **You may stop by the county administration building the week of September 19<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup>, to pick up your supplies for the event from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**
- **The results sheet must be turned in by Thursday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to be considered for an award.** Awards will be given for the largest team and the most bags of trash picked up. An honor system is in place, and we ask that you be honest and not exaggerate your numbers.
- This is planned as a fun, team experience. We hope you will enjoy the day and in turn you will be making our county a nicer, cleaner place to live.
